Discussion took place. It was noted that McGlasson's term would not begin until December 1st since two county board members cannot serve on the 911 board at the same time. *Motion by Young, second by Arbogast to recommend the re-appointment of Jim Woolford and John McGlasson to the ETSB. Concealed Carry– Young questioned whether the board had any discussion on the topic of concealed carry. Young stated that there are nine counties that have the question on the ballot for voters to decide whether it should be allowed. Discussion took place. Consensus of the Committee was to research whether or not the county has the option to allow concealed carry within the county.
